*A Note from our Executive Director, Elissa Lines*

Aloha. Hope you are well. Another week has passed and there is a lot of exciting news to share. We learned this week that we will receive a \$100,000 grant from the Freeman Foundation to repair the windows on the Operations 2nd floor! Additionally, as we shared, we received \$150,000 from the State GIA to restore the second floor. We also received clearance from the Navy to begin the restoration of the Control Tower elevator. And, we received, along with the Battleship Missouri and our national partners, a \$1 million gift from the Bob and Dolores Hope Foundation to support the national commemoration of the 75th anniversary of the end of WWII. Nationally, Bob and Elizabeth Dole will serve as honorary co-chairmen. Events will take place in Washington DC from May 7-10 and in Hawaii, from August 29 - September 2, 2020.
