## Weekly Schedules

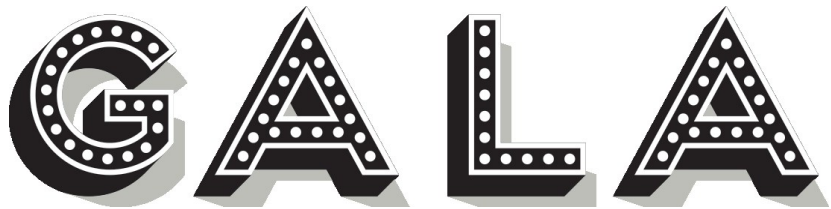
The schedules for the next two weeks are attached. Please review them and let me know if you will be out on vacation anytime soon.
