Big News Regarding the 75th WWII Commemoration

Aloha. Each week brings us exciting news. Big news - the Secretary of Defense has issued a memo supporting the transport of historic WWII aircraft to Hawaii to participate in the 75th WWII Commemoration. This is a huge endorsement of our efforts. Though the events in Hawaii will not begin officially until August 29th as we commemorate the end of war in the Pacific, the 75th WWII Commemoration will begin on May 7th in Washington DC, remembering the end of war in Europe with programs, ceremonies and a mass flyover of 100 WWII warbirds set to launch over the Mall on May 8th immediately following the ceremony at the WWII Memorial.
