December 7, 2013 – 72nd Anniversary of the Attack on Pearl Harbor Blackened Canteen Ceremony hosted by Dr. Hiroya Sugano M.D. aboard the USS Arizona, 10AM. Pacific Aviation Museum Pearl Harbor Chairman of the Board ADM Ron Hays, USN (Ret.) again joins Dr. Sugano in this annual commemoration of peace and reconciliation. Dr. Sugano, the Director General of the Zero Fighter Admirers Club, comes from Japan to conduct the annual ceremony with a silent prayer and pouring bourbon whiskey from a WWII-blackened canteen into the water from the USS Arizona Memorial as an offering to the spirits of the fallen.
