## **Museum's *Open Cockpit Day* Saturday, October 12 Invites Guests to Explore the World of Aviation**

Honolulu, HI – Visitors will have the opportunity to sit in the seat, man the controls, and really feel the history of WWII fighters and modern-day jet fighters at Pacific Aviation Museum Pearl Harbor's second **Open Cockpit Day**, Saturday, October 12, 9am to 5pm. The event is free with paid Museum admission and free for Museum Members.

A partnership with Honolulu Community College allows guests of all ages to "Explore the World of Aviation" through hands-on activities and pop-up exhibits related to avionics, engineering, and remote controlled aircraft. The Birds of Paradise Air Show Team will exhibit aerobatic remote controlled flying. The General Aviation Council of Hawaii (GACH) will also be on hand.

Guests younger than 10 years of age will require parental supervision to climb up and into the aircraft. Guests must also be able to climb boarding stairs and in to a cockpit, to participate. Museum visitors are invited to bring cameras and the Museum staff will do the rest. Pilot's gear, the Museum's vintage aircraft, and meetings with aviation heroes will create a unique family day.
