Museum's *Open Cockpit Day* Saturday, October 18 Invites Guests to Explore the World of Aviation

Honolulu, HI – Visitors will have the opportunity to sit in the seat, man the controls, and really feel the history of WWII fighters and modern-day jet fighters at Pacific Aviation Museum Pearl Harbor's third **Open Cockpit Day**, Saturday, October 18, 10am to 4pm. The event is free with paid Museum admission and free for Museum Members.

Guests younger than 10 years of age will require parental supervision to climb up and into the aircraft. Guests must also be able to climb boarding stairs and in to a cockpit, to participate. Aircraft that will be open include the Museum's F-15 Eagle, F-5 Freedom Fighter, F-111 Aardvark, MiG-21, CH-53 Sea Stallion, and SH-60 Seahawk. Museum visitors are invited to bring cameras and the Museum staff will do the rest. Pilot's gear, the Museum's vintage aircraft, and meetings with aviation heroes will create a unique family day.
