**Title: Jonna Doolittle Hoppes to Present “Hangar Talk”
 And Debut New Book at Pacific Aviation Museum
 Saturday, April 18, 1pm**

Honolulu, HI— Pacific Aviation Museum Pearl Harbor continues its monthly aviation presentation “Hangar Talk,” the third Saturday of each month, 1 to 2pm, in the theatre. The upcoming April 18th presentation will feature Jonna Doolittle Hoppes, granddaughter of WWII hero pilot Jimmy Doolittle, and celebrated author of *Calculated Risk*. “Hangar Talk” is free with paid admission to the Museum.

Hoppes will be debuting and discussing her new book, *Just Doing My Job/Stories of Service from World War II*. Accompanying the author is Dick Hamada a Hawaii-born Japanese American who enlisted in the Army and was recruited into the OSS. As part of Operation Magpie he helped secure the release of American Prisoners of War, including four of the Doolittle Raiders.

Each month, guest lecturers who are aviation authors, pilots, and World War II veterans discuss aviation and the history it made and changed. The series is held in the Pacific Aviation Museum Theatre with a question and answer session included.

The museum’s restaurant, Laniakea Café, is open for lunch until 4:30pm.

Museum general admission is \$14, adults; \$7, children. Kama`aina and Military admission is \$10 adults; \$5, children. Admission is free to Museum members and
