**Title: RIMPAC Military Welcomed with Free Admission  
To Pacific Aviation Museum Pearl Harbor**

Aircraft and military personnel in Hawaii for the biennial “Rim of the Pacific” 2010 war games (RIMPAC) can spend some of their free time at Pacific Aviation Museum Pearl Harbor – for free, as complimentary general admission is being extended to men and women who come to the Museum in uniform.

Additionally, they can add on the Combat Simulator Flights (\$10) and the Aviator’s Tour (\$10) which is the docent-guided tour of both Hangar 37 and 79 and includes the Museum’s new “MiG Alley” Korean War Exhibit. Showcasing the Museum’s recently acquired

MiG-15 and newly restored F-86 Sabre aircraft which flew during the Korean War, the exhibit features a life-sized diorama that depicts “MiG Alley,” the name given by U.S. Air Force pilots to the northwestern portion of North Korea. The Museum’s F-86 Sabre which has been restored for the exhibit, and the Museum’s Soviet-designed MiG-15 were the aircraft used throughout most of the Korean conflict.
