



The Decision Center: Casting Guide

Educators know their students. This guide was created to assist the educator in determining which roles to assign students. Each role is explained and student qualities are suggested; the guide provides space for the educator to list the paired names of each student with the role assigned. **The “Assignment List” is a critical document. Please bring this completed document with you for your field trip, and give it to a Decision Center staff member as soon as you arrive at the Museum.**

Casting Consideration of Role Types

Local Authority

Local Authorities are responsible for determining what aid is needed for their country and communicating their needs to other players. These players also must use a degree of strategy to be successful. Students who can work independently should be considered for this role.

Relief Provider

Relief providers need to communicate and collaborate with all players in the game to gather information and make decisions based on the information they receive. This is a good role for students with strong critical thinking and problem solving skills. Relief providers work closely with pilots, so consider the dynamic of each team as you assign players to this role.

Pilots

Pilots plan and fly multiple missions to other players during the game. This is a good position for students who are social and inquisitive. Pilots can assist relief providers and local authorities with information sharing and game strategy. Pilots work closely with relief providers, so consider the dynamic of each team as you assign players to this role.

VIPs

VIPs are independent players in the game, and each role has a unique contribution to the game. VIPs have the freedom to move about the room at any time and collaborate with all other players. Select class leaders, extroverts and self-starters for this role.

Casting Instructions

Casting is organized by sets of 5. All remaining students will be cast as VIPs.

Groups of up to **15 students** assign students to the **WHITE roles**

+ 5 students add **Roles in Blue**

+ 5 students add **Roles in YELLOW**

+ 5 students add **Roles in GREEN**

Any students not in a factor of 5 will be cast in **VIP Roles listed in PINK**

**Example: Class of 27 students would fill in all the white, teal and yellow roles, and select 2 VIP/Purple roles*
