The Aeronca is a civilian aircraft that carried a father and son to safety after taking fire from a Japanese fighter on December 7, 1941.



The B-25 Mitchell Bomber was specially fitted for carrier operations and was featured in the Tokyo Raid, or the Doolittle Raid.



The Grumman F4F Wildcat fighter represents the Campaign of Guadalcanal as marines fought to protect Henderson Field.



The Mitsubishi A6M Zero fighter was the best carrier-based fighter in the world during the 1940s and took part in the attack on Pearl Harbor.



The Nakajima B5N Kate Bomber was instrumental in destroying Battleship Row and delivering the bomb that sank the USS Arizona.



The P-40 Warhawk pursuit fighter represents the planes flown by Ken Taylor and George Welch which took out some of the enemy airplanes during the Pearl Harbor attack.



The "Battle" of Ni'ihau. Did you know that a Japanese pilot tried to take over the island of Ni'ihau just days after the attack on Pearl Harbor? We have his actual Zero fighter.



The SBD Dauntless dive bomber and scout plane was a standout in the Battle of Midway, the turning point of World War II in the Pacific Theatre.



The Stearman bi-plane was the trainer flown by George H. W. Bush, the 41st President of the United States.
