
Commemorating the 80th Anniversary of the End of WWII: "Salute their Service, Honor their Hope"



Eternal Legacy: Honoring the Greatest Generation and Inspiring the Next

It was onboard the USS Missouri in Tokyo Bay on September 2, 1945 that General Douglas MacArthur, Admiral Chester Nimitz and representatives of the Allied Powers accepted Japan's formal surrender, bringing to an end the bloodiest war in world history. The heartfelt words of General MacArthur, spoken on that day, are still with us:

"It is my earnest hope, and indeed the hope of all mankind, that from this solemn occasion, a better world shall emerge out of the blood and carnage of the past — a world founded upon faith and understanding, a world dedicated to the dignity of man and the fulfillment of his most cherished wish for freedom, tolerance and justice."— General Douglas MacArthur, September 2, 1945

Aligning with the sequence of history, and coming full circle, it is our privileged duty to preserve the legacy of patriotism and sacrifice of "Our Greatest Generation," commemorating their indelible mark upon world history. We are mindful that this historic tribute may be the last commemoration to include participation of WWII survivors.

THE VISION

A four-day public commemoration of the 80th anniversary of the end of WWII to remind Americans of the sacrifice and impact of veterans, service members and all men and women who serve our country – families and civilian heroes who step forward when needed in support of peace and freedom, then and now.

THE THEME

"Eternal Legacy: Honoring the Greatest Generation and Inspiring the Next," providing the foundation for programs and events that will pay tribute to those who gave the ultimate sacrifice in restoring peace to the world and bringing awareness to future generations of their own responsibility to carry forward the legacy of all men and women who serve.

THE EVENTS

Working with US Navy, other military branches and civilian organizations, coordinate the following:

- ★ Public access over the four-day Labor Day weekend to the National Historic Landmark site, the Battleship Missouri, historic hangars, and control tower of the Pearl Harbor Aviation Museum, America's WWII aviation battlefield.
- ★ Opening day Concert featuring nationally acclaimed Gary Sinise and the Lt. Dan Band
- ★ Daily public programs engaging families in learning experiences that educate, challenge and inspire
- ★ Featured movies with guests including Linda Hope and Gary Sinise that showcase the impact of civilian heroes
- * Veteran reunions and gatherings bringing families and service members together in tribute
- ★ Official Commemoration Gala honoring and celebrating service
- ★ Culminating Commemoration Ceremony, honoring the historic signing of the Instrument of Surrender that took place on the Battleship Missouri, formally ending WWII and ushering in a commitment to global peace
